The Panelists



CAROLINE LANTY is a lawyer of the Paris Bar (since 2005) and the former president of the SPA (Société protectrice des animaux), the oldest and the biggest non-profit organization for animal protection in France (2006-2009).

She is the leading lawyer of the L214 Ethics and Animals and the 30 Millions d'Amis, major French non-profit organizations for animal welfare, and fights against animal cruelty before French courts. Author of a book on animal trafficking ("Le Scandale de l'Animal Business", Editions du Rocher), she is a frequent media commentator on animal welfare in France.



LOUIS SCHWEITZER is a high official and a prominent businessman, and is the former Chairman and CEO of Renault from 1992 to 2005. He was also the Chairman of AstraZeneca and is a non-executive director of BNP Paribas, Electricité de France, Veolia Environnement, Volvo AB and L'Oréal, and Vice-Chairman of the Supervisory Board of Philips Electronics. He is dedicated to the question of animal welfare since 2012 as the president of the LFDA (La Fondation Droit Animal), a non-profit organization for animal rights. In 2020 he published a book on the ethics of meat diet ("Faut-il arrêter de manger de la viande?" Edition pour les nuls).



SÉBASTIEN DEMANGE is a specialist of vegetarian diet and human health. He was a member of the nutrition-health commission and the board of directors of the Vegetarian Association of France (2018-2021). Since 2020, he is a member of the National Plant Food Observatory (Observatoire national de l'alimentation végétale), a non-profit organization which promotes healthy and sustainable diets, and is a lecturer of "vegetarian diet" at University of Paris Sorbonne. He founded the Li-festyle medecine non-profit organization in 2022.



SÉBASTIEN ARSAC is one of the most well-known animal welfare activists in France, who co-founded the L214 Ethics and Animals in 2008. As the Managing Investigator, he coordinates the investigations in factory farms and slaughterhouses.

The videos showing the violence suffered by animals for meat production and the lawsuits filed by L214 against the authors of the violence are largely covered by national and regional medias, thus contributing to raise public awareness on animal welfare in France.
